

Thank you for signing up for the “Constellate: A new platform to learn text analysis” workshop.

Before the workshop begins, if you wish to follow along with the demonstrations:

1. Create a new folder on your computer to store the workshop files.
2. Download a zip file containing all the datasets you will need for the workshop to that new folder: <https://maps.library.utoronto.ca/workshops/Constellate/ConstellateFiles.zip>
3. Extract the files into that new folder.
Note: Different computers have different setups. On a Mac, just double-click on the file to extract its files. On a PC, you might first want to install a great little program called 7-Zip: <https://www.7-zip.org/> (if you don't already have it!). Then you should be able to right click on the zip file and select 7-Zip, then Extract Here to extract its files.
4. You should have a PDF Cheat Sheet with some key instructions for following the demonstration, and two CSV files which will be generated and used during the demonstration.
